See 28 C.F.R. § 14.4(b) (stating "[a]ny overpayment in excess of \$10 and any overpayment in excess of \$20 shall be considered overpayments"). We see no merit to plaintiff's argument that we have jurisdiction under the garnishment statute, 28 U.S.C. § 3202, which states, "[a]ny debt... owing to any person... may be garnished in the hands of any garnishees." At issue in the garnishment statute is the state of the debtor's title; the statute refers to "debt," but only to debt that the debtor has "in the sense of having fixed liability and extinguished by payment." *Riggs v. Johnson County*, 73 U.S. (6 Wall.) 166, 181 (1868). In this case, plaintiff's entitlement to a \$10,000 monthly payment from the United States was uncertain until the Court of Federal Claims concluded that plaintiff was eligible for the extra payment. Any other conclusion would require us to speculate as to how the United States intends to characterize the restitution payments at issue in this case. This we decline to do. Finally, the court does not have jurisdiction over this case pursuant to the Court of Federal Claims' Tucker Act jurisdiction over cases arising under the Constitution or federal statutes that do not expressly provide for money damages and cases under the Contract Disputes Act. See 28 U.S.C. § 1491(a)(1). As plaintiff cannot bring this action under either the Tucker Act or the Contract Disputes Act, the court
