In 2013, the Reallifecam app was announced for the iPhone (available on the App Store), and in 2014 an Android version was introduced. In addition, the Reallifecam app is available for Windows Phone and Windows 8 users, as well as for mobile operating systems based on Android version 3.0. In August 2014, the Reallifecam app was sold for \$600 million to the British company HushHush. That deal was completed at the end of 2014. The Reallifecam app is one of the apps on the Android Market that have been classified as malicious, including under the heading "Unwanted Apps." On the page of the app, Akella LLC is listed as its developer, which raises certain suspicions. In February 2012 information appeared that the company "Akella" (St. Petersburg) was developing Android applications under the name "Reallifecam" for sale. The application was available for download in the Google Play store in 2012. Reallifecam application was created by the developer LLC "Akella", the same way the application was created by LLC "Akella". In February 2012 it was reported that the generated in order to illegally gain profit by collecting users' data in a video conference. In October 2012, when the number of Reallifecam users reached 1 million and research was conducted, it was revealed that the Reallifecam app could be used to steal users' bank card data and for spam. In November 2012, a new type of malware was detected that made use of Reallifecam video conferencing and sent spam. Due to the appearance of another malware type, the Reallifecam app was removed in November 2012. This malware was found by ESET and examined by ESET Labs. The new malware is called Tigrm. Tigrm was infected by the Reallifecam application (which in turn was infected with Spyware and HiddenTrack type malware). none dd2bc28256
